

In your time with SANDIS, what has been your favorite project so far?


Being a part of the push to update our documentation page - SANDIS Knowledge.










Tips & Tricks to enhance your SANDIS experience.

The **Filter & Search** feature is commonly used to narrow the information being displayed in most table interfaces in SANDIS. Users can filter a report by DOB, status, user code, and more! When Filter & Search is executed, SANDIS will populate only the information that matches what is entered.

Here are the steps to Filter & Search:

- 1. Open a program with a table interface
- 2. Enter the qualifying information to search in the column(s)



Note: If the table does not support the Filter & Search feature, you may need to use the **Filter & Find** feature.

Here are the steps to Filter & Find:

- 1. Open a program with a table interface
- 2. Right-click the navy blue bar
- 3. Select Filter
- 4. Enter the qualifying information to filter the column
